







INDIA'S EXPORTS TO RUSSIA SOAR AMIDST SANCTIONS FEARS

India has witnessed a remarkable surge in exports to Russia, driven by the ongoing conflict between Russia and Ukraine as well as the subsequent economic sanctions imposed on Moscow.

Figures indicate that the export of engineering goods, machinery, machine parts, and aircraft spares from India experienced a significant boost during the previous financial years.



Indian exporters face significant challenges amid increased trade with sanctions-hit Russia. Despite a 35% surge in exports to Russia, banking complications and fear of sanctions dampen enthusiasm. Some exporters route goods through the UAE, while others avoid direct transactions to risks. The minimize complex trade dynamics are further complicated by geopolitical cautious banks and tensions.





INDIA RECORDS TRADE DEFICIT WITH 9 OUT OF 10 TRADE PARTNERS IN FY24

India recorded a trade deficit with nine of its top ten trading partners during the 2023-24 fiscal year, according to official data released today.

The deficit increased significantly with major economies like China, Russia, South Korea and Hong Kong compared to the previous year.

China remained India's largest trading partner with USD 118.4 billion in two-way commerce, slightly surpassing the US at USD 118.28 billion.





India maintained a substantial USD 36.74 billion trade surplus with the United States. However, trade deficits with China, Russia, South Korea, and Hong Kong increased, with the China deficit reaching USD 85 billion. Conversely, deficits with the UAE, Saudi Arabia, Indonesia, and Iraq narrowed. Experts warn that a rising overall trade deficit can strain the currency, external debt, and foreign reserves.


India's total trade deficit for 2023-24 slightly narrowed to USD 238.3 billion, and the government aims to further reduce it by boosting exports and promoting self-reliance.




