# INDIA WEIGHS SUGAR EXPORTS AMID LOWER OUTPUT FORECAST

India, the world's biggest sugar producer after Brazil, may allow some sugar exports in the upcoming 2024-25 season after assessing the final sugarcane sowing and output data, government sources said on Wednesday.



India's sugar production for the next season is estimated to decrease due to lower cane planting in Karnataka, leading to a proposed export of 1 million tonnes.

Current restrictions on sugar exports may be reviewed after July based on monsoon planting data. India mainly exports sugar to neighboring countries and may need to reconsider export policies due to lower output.





# INDIA TIGHTENS OVERSIGHT OF DEFENCE EXPORTS AMID MISUSE CONCERNS

The Indian Ministry of Defence is increasing monitoring and enforcement of export rules for defence equipment manufactured in the country.

This move comes after reports that some Indian-made weapons and military gear have ended up in unauthorised hands abroad.

India's defence manufacturing sector has grown rapidly in recent years, producing arms and equipment for both domestic use and international export markets.





India's defense production value exceeded 1 trillion rupees last year, with the private sector contributing over 210 billion rupees.

Defense exports reached 210 billion rupees in 2023-24, driven by private companies.

To prevent unauthorized weapon transfers, India plans to monitor sensitive material imports and scrutinize exports.


Recipient nations must certify no re-transfer to third parties. India maintains defense trade bans with countries like Ukraine, Russia, Turkey, China, and Pakistan.
