

INDIA'S EXPORTS RISE TO 115 COUNTRIES DESPITE GLOBAL UNCERTAINTIES

India's merchandise exports expanded to as many as 115 countries out of 238 total destinations during the 2023-24 fiscal year, highlighting the country's resilience amid global economic uncertainties, according to the latest data from the Ministry of Commerce.



India's exports to top markets like the US, UAE, China, and UK contribute significantly to total exports. While merchandise exports decreased by 3%, services exports increased to USD 341.1 billion in 2023-24. Overall exports of goods and services reached a record high of USD 778.2 billion with a 0.23% growth. India's global merchandise export share rose from 1.70% to 1.82% from 2014 to 2023, ranking 17th. Notably, exports to key markets such as UAE, Singapore, UK, and China grew, showcasing India's export competitiveness and resilience.



S.O....(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 148 of the Central Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017 (12 of 2017) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), the Central Government, on the recommendations of the Council, hereby makes the following amendments in the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Finance (Department of Revenue) No. 04/2024–Central Tax, dated the 5th January, 2024 published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part II, Section 3, Sub-section (ii), vide number S.O. 85(E), dated the 5th January, 2024, namely:-

In the said notification, in para 4, for the words and letters "1st day of April, 2024", the words and letters "15th day of May, 2024" shall be substituted.

2. This notification shall come into force from 1st day of April, 2024.

The UAE and India aim to strengthen economic ties through the CEPA by eliminating duties, creating labor pathways, and enhancing cooperation in various industries.




