INDORE TOPS MP IN EXPORTS WORTH OVER RS 20,000 CR

Indore emerged as the leading exporter in Madhya Pradesh for the financial year 2023-24, with outbound shipments worth over Rs 20,000 crore.

The city's exports grew by 12 per cent year-on-year, reaching Rs 20,256 crore, driven primarily by medicines, textiles, and engineering products.



Dhar ranked second in Madhya Pradesh for exports, driven by the pharmaceutical industry. Overall, the state's exports in 2023-24 decreased slightly to Rs 65,255 pharmaceutical The crore. sector, including medicines and pharmaceutical products, was a major contributor. Indore led in exports, with Dhar following. Key exports from Madhya Pradesh included pharmaceuticals, soy, cotton, machinery, garments, chemicals, aluminum, electrical machinery, and plastics. Malwa-Nimar region increased saw soybean meal exports compared to the previous year.

GOVT PLANS TO CURB PULSES & EDIBLE OIL IMPORTS IN ITS 100-DAY AGENDA

The Central government is planning a special focus on reducing imports of pulses and edible oils as part of its 100-day agenda.

A senior official said stringent policy measures similar to those taken over the past 1.5 years will be introduced.

The agriculture ministry is drafting a new scheme aimed at achieving self-sufficiency in pulses by 2027 to cut huge import expenses.

Despite improvements since 2011, the demand-supply gap for pulses like tur, urad, and masur is widening, necessitating annual imports of 2.5-3 million tonnes.





India's agriculture exports reached USD 48.9 billion in 2023-24, showing an 8% decrease from the previous year.

While edible oil imports decreased, pulse imports increased to a six-year high of USD 3.75 billion. The focus is on oilseeds, pulses, biofuel, and farmer welfare to reduce imports and stabilize prices.


India aims to boost oil palm cultivation and increase pulse production to reduce imports by 2027.
