



# RAJNATH SINGH TARGETS MILITARY EXPORTS WORTH RS 50,000 CR ANNUALLY BY 2028-29

Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, upon resuming his role, has outlined ambitious goals for India's defence sector.

He aims to achieve annual military exports worth Rs 50,000 crore by 2028-2029, a significant increase from the record Rs 21,083 crore reached in the 2023-24 financial year.



Singh aims to boost 'Make in India' for defense production, establish new export agency, equip armed defense forces with advanced weapons, prioritize soldier welfare, and focus on the Indian Ocean Region's defense strategy. Plans include visiting the Eastern Naval Command and finalizing military export deals with countries like the Philippines, Vietnam, and Armenia. Initial actions involve reviewing the ministry's 100-day Action Plan, emphasizing veteran welfare and Ex-Servicemen Welfare issues.



# INDIA EMERGING AS FASTEST GROWING STEEL CONSUMPTION MARKET

India's domestic steel makers are grappling with a dual challenge - sluggish local demand and a slump in Chinese real estate weighing on exports.

The sustained high output from Chinese steel mills is also impacting India's steel shipments to key markets like Vietnam and the United Arab Emirates (UAE).

However, India's growth as the fastest expanding steel consumption market provides an opportunity for imports. "As long as appetite for steel keeps growing, India would allow Chinese imports," said Amit Bhargava of KPMG India.





India's steel exports decreased in fiscal 2023-24, with a notable decline in exports to the UAE. Chinese imports are impacting Indian steel prices domestically.


Higher infrastructure spending postelections could increase steel demand, but Indian producers may seek protection against cheaper imports due to high raw material costs.
