









# HIGHER U.S. TARIFFS ON CHINA COULD BENEFIT INDIAN MEDICAL, INDUSTRIAL EXPORTS

The Biden administration has announced plans to levy substantially higher tariffs on a range of Chinese products, including electric vehicles, batteries, medical supplies, and critical minerals.

This move is expected to create potential opportunities for Indian medical and industrial exporters to increase their presence in the U.S. market, according to government officials and trade experts.



The White House raised tariffs on Chinese electric vehicles, solar cells, and steel/aluminum products while increasing duties on non-lithium-ion tariffs battery parts. New approximately \$18 billion worth Chinese imports into the U.S. India stands to benefit in sectors like medical supplies due to strong domestic production capacities. However, there are concerns about Chinese goods being diverted to markets like India at lower prices.

Notification No. 36/2024 - Customs (N.T.)

New Delhi, dated the 16th May, 2024 26 Vaisakha 1946 (SAKA)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 of the Customs Act, 1962 (52 of 1962), and in supersession of the Notification No. 34/2024-Customs(N.T.), dated 2nd May, 2024 except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs hereby determines that the rate of exchange of conversion of each of the foreign currencies specified in column (2) of each of Schedule I and Schedule II annexed hereto, into Indian currency or vice versa, shall, with effect from 17th May, 2024, be the rate mentioned against it in the corresponding entry in column (3) thereof, for the purpose of the said section, relating to imported and export goods.





# FIEO FORECASTS 14% RISE IN INDIA'S MERCHANDISE EXPORTS TO USD 510 BN FOR FY25

The Federation of Indian Export Organisations (FIEO) has projected a 14 per cent increase in India's merchandise exports for the fiscal year 2024-25, estimating a figure between USD 500-510 billion.

This growth is expected to be driven by technology-driven sectors such as machinery, electrical and electronic goods, automobiles, pharmaceuticals, and biotechnology, which have received a boost from the government's production-linked incentive schemes.





FIEO President Ashwini Kumar is optimistic about India's export growth, citing traditional markets and free trade agreements.

The services sector is expected to contribute significantly. Concerns include potential dumping of Chinese goods and challenges in labor-intensive export sectors.


Measures suggested include promoting ecommerce exports through social media and addressing the demand for skilled labor by seeking visas for Chinese technicians and engineers.


