

INDIA-UAE FTA PROPELS GOLD IMPORTS I INDIA BY 210%

India's gold and silver imports from the United Arab Emirates (UAE), a partner in the India-UAE Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA), have surged by a staggering 210 per cent to reach USD 10.7 billion in the fiscal year 2023-24, according to a report by the Global Trade Research Initiative (GTRI).

This sharp rise is primarily attributed to the import duty concessions granted by India to the UAE under the CEPA.



The CEPA signed in February 2022 allows India to import silver at a 7% tariff rate and metric tonnes of gold at a 1% concession. India increased gold and silver imports from the UAE through the IIBX in GIFT City. Concerns were raised about the high sustainability of import suggesting lower import duties and stricter regulations. Rising gold and silver imports contribute to India's current account deficit. Recommendations include not including these items in **FTAs** and reviewing tariff concessions.

INDIA'S THREE-WHEELER EXPORTS CONTINUE TO SLIDE IN FY 2024-25

India's three-wheeled vehicle exports continue to decline in fiscal year 2024-25, with key markets like Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Nigeria, and Egypt showing weak demand. Preliminary data shows an 11.3% year-over-year drop in May exports.

Major automakers Piaggio and TVS Motor Company experienced export decreases of 16% and 19.9% in the first two months of the fiscal year.





India's three-wheeler exports have dropped consecutively, attributed to economic crises in countries like Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Nigeria, and Egypt. Factors include high inflation, political risks, currency devaluation, and import restrictions in Africa.


Some nations have banned three-wheeler imports due to congestion and safety concerns. While exports are not a major part of India's commercial vehicle sales, the domestic three-wheeler segment has seen growth, especially in electric vehicles. TVS Motor plans to expand its electric vehicle range. Despite challenges, experts believe Indian automakers can meet market demand if conditions improve.
