

INDIA'S POULTRY EXPORTS SOAR TO \$184 MILLION IN FY24

In the 2023-24 financial year, India's poultry exports reached a record USD 184.58 million, driven by demand for products like eggs and egg powder from countries such as Oman and Sri Lanka. This surge was influenced by disruptions in production and shipments to West Asia due to the Ukraine crisis and Turkey's earthquake. Indian poultry products face tough



Indian poultry products face tough competition in global markets due to higher prices post-normal production in countries. other Producers seek government incentives for sustainability and market share maintenance. Exporters aim for government support new to enter markets like Russia, Indonesia, and Malaysia. West Asia, particularly Oman, UAE, and Qatar, is a key market. Sri Lanka and Maldives are also significant buyers. A dedicated lab is in quality control needed Namakkal to reduce costs. Poultry exports from India rebounded strongly in the past three years after a low in 2020-21.



INDIAN SPICE EXPORTS FACE 40% DECLINE AMID Contamination concerns

India's lucrative spice export industry is facing a potential crisis as several countries have banned or are investigating popular Indian spice mixes over allegations of contamination with ethylene oxide, a toxic chemical.

Five nations - Singapore, Hong Kong, Maldives, Australia, and Nepal - have recently announced bans or investigations into spice mixes sold by major Indian brands MDH and Everest due to suspected ethylene oxide contamination above permissible limits.





Ethylene oxide is used in pesticides and food preservation but can be harmful in excess.

The Federation of Indian Spice Stakeholders warned of a 40% drop in spice exports due to contamination issues.


Nepal and other countries banned certain spice mixes over quality concerns. Indian agencies are increasing quality checks to avoid a crisis that could significantly impact spice exports, a major Indian industry.
