

INDIA'S TRADE IMBALANCE WITH RUSSIA SWELLS AMID RISING ENERGY IMPORTS

India's trade deficit with Russia has surged to USD 57.18 billion in the fiscal year 2023-2024, marking a 33 per cent annual increase, according to data released by the Ministry of Commerce.

This substantial imbalance is primarily driven by India's heightened imports of discounted Russian crude oil in the wake of Western sanctions imposed on Moscow following the invasion of Ukraine.



India's imports from Russia rose by 33% to USD 61.44 billion in FY 2023-2024, with crude oil imports surging to USD 46.49 billion. However, exports to Russia only increased by 35% to USD 4.26 billion, resulting in a growing trade deficit. India's reliance on Russian energy evident, with crude oil supplies is imports skyrocketing. Russia's sanctions have positioned it as India's primary crude oil supplier, offering discounts that could lead to significant cost savings.





INDIA TIGHTENS IMPORT NORMS FOR SECOND-HAND ELECTRONICS, IT GOODS

The Directorate General of Foreign (DGFT) Trade has issued 13/2024-25 notification no. restricting the import of all secondhand electronics and IT goods notified under the Electronics and IT (Requirements Goods of Registration) Compulsory Order. 2021 with effect from May 20, 2024.

As per the new norms, import of such notified second-hand electronics and IT goods will now require a restricted import authorisation, subject to conditions laid down in the order.





The import of unregistered or non-compliant products is prohibited under the new order. Electronics and IT goods must be registered with the Bureau of Indian Standards and comply with BIS labeling requirements.


A Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology exemption letter is required for consignment imports. This measure aims to uphold quality standards, reduce e-waste, and align with Basel Convention commitments.


